UPCOMING WORKSHOPS

6 Aug 2019, 0900-1 pm: Painting barn quilts for the Guild's show signs. \$20 for individual paintings. This is held at 3518 Ojibwa Street.

10 Aug 2019, 0900-1200: workshop for the jellyroll rug if we have enough people sign up early. 9 am to 1200 (or when everyone is ready to leave). \$15 for the pattern and tips, or \$20 for pattern with a jellyroll OR the necessary batting. Held at Guild Hall.

8 Oct, 0900- 2 pm : Patty Goodsell, \$30/person for the workshop and \$10 for the kit which will include everything for the class except for personal sewing tools--the handouts, templates, and fabric—She will be teaching 5 dimensional flowers, all starting with a circle and would add making your own chenille, which she uses use for butterfly bodies, and ultrasuede ladybugs, plus easy ways to make bias strips.

More about the August Program and Workshop

Both evening and day meetings will be a trunk exhibit from Susan Ritter, showcasing her journey as a quilter. The journey begins with many mistakes and wrong turns, but continues through some serendipitous discoveries. She will share some of her record keeping as well as some quilts you may not have seen.

Yes, she's still working with rainbows, but now using scraps to make a small rug and other items. The class—making jelly roll rugs—accompanying this program will be on Saturday, August 10, and there are still a few spaces.
