**1. Wendy Seals Address: 1482 E. Loma Lane**

Directions: From Highway 92, turn west at Yaqui. (If you turn east, you're at the Squirrel's Nest.) Drive about 1.5 miles and turn south on Calle Encina. (If you turn north, you're at Our Lady of the Mountain church.) In about ½ mile, the road dead ends, turn right (west). Mine is the driveway with the newspaper boxes next to it.

"The best thing about my quilt room is that it has a door. It usually looks like it's been recently vandalized, so it's nice to shut the mess out of sight. I can have several projects going at once plus all the stuff from prior projects that I mean to tidy up – you get the picture. The second-best thing is I have serious lumens in there. 1200-watt bulbs in every light fixture that can take it, so I can sew at 3am just as easily as at 3pm. Welcome everyone!"


**3. Joyce Larsen, Address: 2722 Lopez Link off St Andrews in PDS.**
