

# Gone Temari Class III

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Red Hot Star:

- Click on HOW TO tab at the top and then click on the Red Hot Star link for the patterns.
- Divide your mari ball into a SIMPLE 10. Check out the Temari Kai website for easy instructions. Instead of dividing into 8 orange wedges, divide into 10 (use the calculator).
- Check out the link on the left side of the page for 5- pointed star for a sneak preview on what & how we are going to do it!!

You will need:

- A mari of 25-27 cm in circumference. Use about  $\frac{3}{4}$ + cup of rice hulls
- Lovely contrasting color for marking guidelines that will stay in .
- Thread of your choice to contrast with the color of the ball.

In my example I've used a black ball with silver marking guidelines and red/ gold pearl cotton for the star. #5 pearl cotton is always good.
