**2017:**

October 3, 2017: Kay Wentworth will share her techniques for turning fabric into art by helping us create Portraits of Our Pets. This workshop demonstrates raw-edge appliqué techniques that do not use glue or adhesive materials such as wonder under. Pick out your picture (does not have to be a pet). Class will cost \$30 per person, minimum of 10 students. The workshop will be all day (9AM-3PM). Check out her website at <https://kaywentworth.carbonmade.com/>.

October 7, 2017: *Cynthia Hatch will offer the second in a series of three classes on how to make and decorate your very own temari ball. During this class you will learn two new stitches and make a dragon fly designed Temari ball. Class will be from 9 to noon. Class two will cost \$15 and you will bring all your own materials to include your mari ball. The date of class 3 is Saturday, 4 Nov 2017.*

October 10 and 14, 2017: Swan Sheridan of Swan Amity Studios will host a Tuffet workshop. She has reduced her price down to \$125 and has only seven patterns left. The workshop will take two days: Day one you will receive sewing instructions. On day two we will assemble the tuffets. The cost includes the pattern and all stool materials. You will just need to provide your choice of fabric. All tuffets have a finish size of 18" wide x 8" of foam with 4 1/2" feet for a total of ~13" tall when the base is included. During this class you will learn two more stitches so you can make a more complex and beautiful Temari ball. After this class you will be more comfortable tacking simple and complex 8, 10 or 12 designs. Class will be from 9 to noon. Class two will cost \$15 and you will bring all your own materials to include your mari ball.*

January 9, 2018: *Darlene Miller will walk us in circles with her class on Radiant Suns. Your fabric selection will make each quilt unique while expanding your comfort zone with circles!! Now is your chance! Learn an easy no pin technique to create beautiful smooth curved seams and blocks. No experience necessary and easy for beginners as well. You will be surprised at what you can create. With your choice of color and fabrics you can have suns radiating or simply an array of beautiful colors. Class time will be 9AM-3PM; Class and pattern cost: \$38; optional template available for \$27 (most order from Eileen NLT 8 Jan 2018 to be available in class)*

Feb 6, 2018: Dusty and Stephanie Farrell: multiple potential classes 0900-1200 and 6-9PM: Dusty Farrell is available to present a class on Longarm techniques, while Stephanie Farrell can present a morning and evening classes on quilting with your home (domestic) machine. Number and type of classes will depend on interest. Cost \$25 per person. Quilters will be able to sample Dusty's rulers and template during all classes. 3 April 2018: Introduction to "Heat Set" Machine Appliqué by Grace Errea. Grace will teach her new and revolutionary "Heat Set Appliqué" technique that is fool proof. This technique leaves the quilt and the fabric soft and manageable, and produces a no-fray raw edge appliqué.
