Some organizations receiving quilts include: cancer treatment centers, respite and assisted living centers, hospice care, fire departments, crisis centers, infant programs, CASA, Forgach House, Buena High School, and others.

We honor our veterans with quilts through Quilts of Valor, Home of the Brave, the VA Auxiliary, and Disabled American Veterans.
