# **Membership Spotlight:** : Meet Janet Murphy

I took my first quilting class in 1979 from a neighbor lady. I was between jobs while living in IL so I was going to school and learning how to quilt! We used cardboard templates and scissors to cut the pieces, and it was a hand quilt as you go sampler quilt pattern. I finished the blocks and pieced them together before going back to work. I ended up paying someone else to hand quilt the sashing and borders and it is the ugliest quilt I have ever made! I did not quilt again until the early 90's after I stopped working, but really got into quilting after moving to AZ in 1994. When I joined the HSQG in 1997 (I think) it was a life saver for me. I met so many wonderful ladies and learned so much. I have taken many classes over the years; some I loved and some not so much. I don't do anything really difficult anymore and I still really like paper piecing.



#### **QUILT SHOW SET-UP**

Good day, Ladies.

I would like to remind you all that we are not allowed into the Buena High School cafeteria until 4pm the afternoon of Friday, March 1, 2024 for the quilt show set-up. Please park your cars in the adjacent parking lot to alleviate blocking quilt show delivery vehicles. And, if you do park in the ramp area, move your car as soon as it is unloaded. The broad stroke plan is to unload all the boutique merchandise and display fixtures first.

Then, we will break into row set up teams, and work with them to erect the poles and drapes.

After dinner, the teams will divide into two dirty ladder climbers, two semi clean display pole inserters, and a clean quilt handler. This will keep the quilts clean by not having people touch poles and then quilts.

The teams will use S-hooks, and suspension cables to hang and adjust each quilt as they are hung. The idea is not to have to come back and adjust the height of the quilts once they are hung. The ladder people can stay on the ladders, the semi- clean people can fit the quilts onto the rods, and hand them up to the ladder folks, and the clean person can advise how to best adjust for height and level. This way, once you have worked down a row, it is com-

Please sign up in advance so we know who, and how many to expect to help. If you would, please put a ½ inch wrench in your pocket, and bring a light-weight ladder; everything else will be furnished. All the quilt show signup books are on the table under the bulletin board.

Keep It Simple Sweetie

**HSQG Challenge 2024** 

Back to basics. Plain & simple. Solid color fabric only. Think Amish.

Kona 2024 color of the year included – Julep

Color choices, pattern, and quilting are the focus this year.

Hand embroidery is the only allowed embellishment. Quilting technique of your choice – pieced, applique, etc.

No larger than 60" perimeter -- 12"x 18", 18" x 12", 15" x 15" for example. It can be smaller and can be an irregular shape.

3 layers (top, batting, backing), guilted by hand or sewing machine (not embroidery machine), finished edge, label and sleeve.

**SIGN UP BY JULY 1**: at HSQG clubhouse, info sheet includes a 5" charm of Kona Julep. Limit 42 (because that's all that was in the charm pack )

**IMPORTANT**: Email JoAnn at vandine@O.com by **October 15** with your name, name of quilt, and size of quilt.

20 Mar – Class will begin at 9:00am. This Wednesday will be a workshop given by our own guild member, Wendy H. Wendy will instruct us on the process of stack and whack. Stack and whack designs create intricate kaleidoscope patterns, full of vibrant, dramatic patterns each having distinctive designs depending on the fabric you choose. Join us for a fun filled day! The workshop is free and there will be a supply list available at the guild.







22 May 2023 – The workshop will last about 6 hours and will start at 9:00 a.m. This Wednesday we will have a workshop by Joyce Holley. "It's all about the wings" is a workshop on Flying Geese Units and how to get them to "Fly" and "Atlantic Flyway" using the Wing Clipper Method for making 4 perfect units at a time with the Studio 180 "Wing Clipper 1". Plus opening the process of constructing Migrating Geese using the Quilters Magic Wand. The class fee is \$40.00 and requires you to have the Studio 180 "Wing Clipper 1" ruler. Joyce will bring rulers for the purchase price of \$27.00. This includes a 10% discount. You can see photos on facebook "noahandhersisters" and there is a finished Atlantic Flyway quilt about 5 or 6 rows down in her photos. We will post pictures in next months newsletter and at the guild.

**New guidelines for making backs for quilt tops:** please make the backing at least 5" longer on each of the top & bottom edges and 4" on each side. This allows for ease in loading the backing without the quilter having to add an extra leader.

Also, please sew down any seam edges from piecing so the seam doesn't come apart in loading.

Every little bit helps our long-arms who volunteer time & thread!
