

# Blotto Block - February – May 2020

Blotto Drawing - Wednesday, May 6<sup>th</sup>

**Block:** Easy Peasy

**\*\*\*Please make sure your block meets the size and color requirements to qualify for the drawing!!!**

**Block Size:** 10 ½" x 10 ½"

**Guild fabric:** Cut two - 2 ½" x 10 ½" strips from blue batik fabric

**Your fabric:** Cut four - 2 ½" x 6 ½" strips from one batik "A" fabric

Cut one - 2 ½" x 6 ½" strip from contrasting color batik "B" fabric for center strip

\*\*\*\*\* NOTE: Sew all seams a scant 1/4" \*\*\*\*\*

*Remember: There is a color photo of the current Blotto block on the HSQG website under the Blotto tab.*

1. Cut all fabric, including Guild fabric, per cutting instructions above.
2. Sew two of the "A" rectangle strips to each long side of the "B" center strip using a scant ¼" seam allowance (See Figure A). Press seams away from the center. This unit should measure 6 ½" square.

3. Sew the two remaining "A" rectangle strips to the top and bottom of the 6 ½" square unit (See Figure B). Press seams away from the center. This unit should measure 6 ½" wide by 10 ½" high.

4. Sew the two rectangles provided by the guild to each long side of the unit (See Figure C). Press seams away from the center. This unit will measure 10 ½" square.
