

Microwavable Bowl Holder (July 2014)

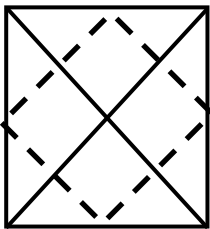
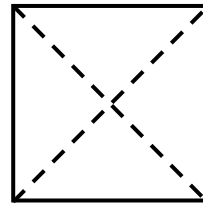
Two 10" squares coordinating 100 % cotton fabric

One 9 1/2" square 100% cotton batting (check scrim too)

100% Cotton thread

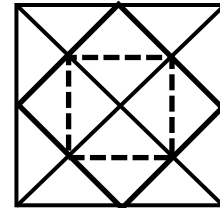
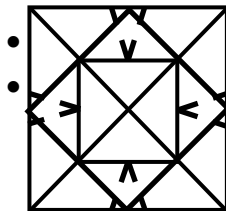
Press one square in quarters. Sew batting to the wrong side of one piece of fabric as follows:

- Sew an X in the square from corner to corner diagonally



- Snip the centers of the sides to mark & sew a square from one mark to the next side.

- Sew an inner square using the crossing points of the diagonal lines.



- Sew a dart about 3" long and 3/4" deep on the center of each edge on each side.

- On the plain square, sew darts on all 4 edges.
- Place the 2 squares right sides together. Sew together with a 1/4" seam around the perimeter, leaving an opening for turning right side out. Trim corners. Turn; sew the opening closed by hand, OR pin the opening closed and top stitch around the whole thing with an 1/8" seam, which closes the opening at the same time.
- Tack through all fabric in the center of the square to hold the pieces together when washing. Quilting can be either on the outside or inside, your choice.
