This process can be applied to both free motion design work as well as working with your favorite longarm quilter to find the best programmable options.

**Workshop: 4 & 5 Aug @ 1 – 3 pm.** : Swan Amity's workshop is "Quilting with Intention" The cost is \$30 per person and will also be conducted via Zoom. A supply list is posted on the website. Improve your skills at designing quilting motifs for your individual quilt.

**Quilting with Intention Workshop:** In this class, students will explore the creation of quilting plans that partner with the design of their quilt top. Students are invited to bring a quilt top they have completed. During class we will begin by looking closely at several examples of contextualized quilting and then move on to creating personalized quilting plans for each student, taking into account their skill level and personal quilting strengths.

Each student will begin with a few basic ideas, create drawings and plans (including discussion of thread, colors, and methods), test their plans on their machines, and workshop their ideas with Swan and the class. Every student will have the opportunity to leave class with a defined plan to quilt their completed top.

## Supply list:

### **Basic Supplies – (bring what makes you comfortable to use your machine in addition to this list)**

- A machine in good working order capable of dropping the feed dogs
- Free motion foot for your machine
- A package of 80/12 needles
- Self threading needle (not the machine needle, but rather the hand needles. Side threading needles are also awesome)
- Small scissors you can get up close to your project surface with
- #50 weight cotton thread (pre-wind 2-3 bobbins in the same thread) Choose contrasting colors to the fabrics you bring. (If you know the thread you plan to use on your finished quilt, you may wish to bring that as well)
- A washout marking pen
- Chalk Marking tool
- Several sheets of paper or a notebook
- one regular lead pencil, #2 is fine (mechanical pencils are great for this class)
- Ruler (at least 12" – 3"x 18" is also great)
- If you have template shapes you like for your design (circles, hexies, curves) bring a few examples
- Freezer paper (1 yard)

### **Fabric and Batting:**

- At least three 16" Fabric and Batting Sandwiches to test your designs. (Choose a batting similar to what you plan to use for the finished quilt.)
- Optional items – Quilting gloves, extension table for your machine, Supreme Slider Free Motion slider, extra threads, examples of quilting you like. (I will have my machine quilting gloves available for sale.)
